Sept – Dec 2017

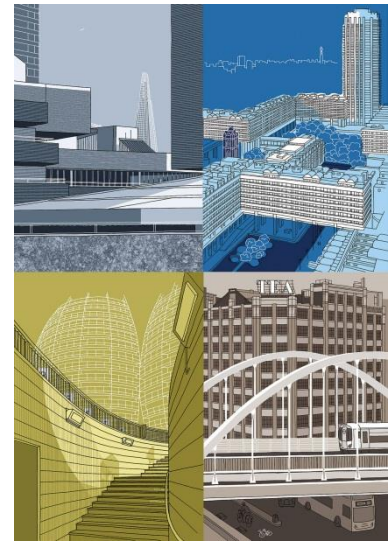
The Society of Children's Book Writers and Illustrators (UK): *Pictures at Play*
