What makes a Monster? Were they always evil and can they ever have redemption?

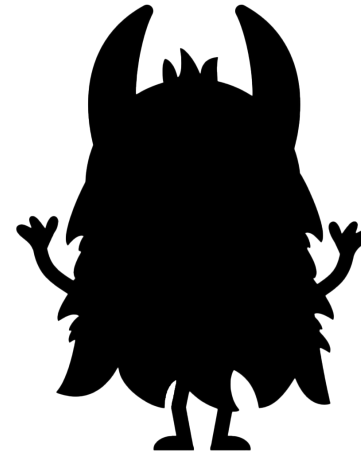
When looking at the themes and archetypes of myths, Equinox have deconstructed why these stories were relevant then and what relevance they hold today.
