

A show about having fun, even when the world is at its most daunting

Is it a bed? Or a boat? Or a giant slice of toast? For Naz and Iggy and their eight friends, their bed is a place where imagination can fill their tummies with tasty treats and take them to familiar warm places. Well, sometimes.

Join the boat-bed's disparate crew as they dream up playful tales of pirates, misunderstood sharks and fishing trips that hook some unexpected catches. But what happens if the bed is not big enough to fit everyone in? How do they decide who gets to stay and who has to go?

This humorous and inventive new show celebrates the power of imaginary play and proves there's always enough room to have fun, even when the world is at its most daunting.

Written by award-winning teenage fiction writer Steve Tasane (*Child I, Blood Donors*), *Ten in the Bed* sensitively explores the child refugee experience, where the power of invention offers an escape from reality.

Framed by an evocative soundscape, it is the latest exhilarating production for 3-8s from Half Moon, the UK's leading small-scale young people's venue and touring company.

We don't educate, as such, as there are not always correct answers or solutions when talking about or addressing prejudice, social injustices, equality and social inclusion. Like any good story, the aim is to allow the audience to join up their own dots, think creatively and ask questions so they can discover their own answers to complex issues even at an early age through experiencing a high-quality theatre adventure.

Technical Requirements (venues)

- **Get-in:** 2.5 hours before half with pre-rig completed prior to get in.
- Get-out: 1 hour.
- **Venue Configuration:** End on. Performing area minimum 5m (wide) by 5m (depth) with 3.5m (height).
- Lighting: A full lighting plan will be supplied. We will require the use of the venues lighting desk.
- Sound: We tour a Mac with QLAB but will need to plug this into the venues P.A. system.
- Staffing: On tour, there are 2 performers plus a company technical stage manager who will operate lighting and sound, but we do require 1 in-house technician to assist with get-in, focus, plot and the get-out.

- Parking: For a sprinter size van.
- Facilities: Dressing room/s for 2 performers.

Technical Requirements (non-traditional spaces inc. rural touring spaces/libraries/schools)

The piece can perform self-sufficiently without blackout as we can tour our own sound. All we need is 1 contact to help with get-ins. Set-up times are 90 mins, exit within 45 mins. This flexibility allows families/children to access the work where they live, go to school or spend their free time.

A playful show about (mis)understanding the rules

Who says a line should always be straight? What's wrong with zig zags? How about curves?

Boxed In follows the journey of someone who can't make head nor tail of the unspoken rules that surround us all. Sometimes stop means go and go means stop. Are you supposed to go this way or that? Sometimes it's up and sometimes it's down. In a world where everyone else seems to understand, it can all get a bit confusing. And when you get it wrong, you're made to sit out, but you don't understand why. It seems so unfair.

Boxed In explores the unspoken barriers of attitudes, social etiquette and behaviour that surround us. How do you know a barrier is there if you can't see it? And if you can't see it, how can you remove it?

This heartfelt story is about being made to feel naughty, just because the rules don't make sense.

Boxed in is a Daryl & Co. and Half Moon co-production; an exciting collaboration by a ground-breaking Disabled-led theatre company and the UK's leading small-scale young people's venue and touring company.

Booking *Boxed In* is an opportunity to accelerate inclusive practices and programming by diversifying the offer to audiences, improving knowledge of Relaxed experiences and so accessing new and diverse audiences.

Boxed In is largely non-verbal, so is accessible to a wide range of people including BSL users and non-English speakers without BSL/captions, and is presented by companies experienced in providing Relaxed Performances suitable for Disabled audiences.

Performance Length and Audience Restrictions

- Performance lasts 45 minutes, including post-show playtime (no interval).
- Due to the intimacy of the piece and the age focus, capacity should not exceed 100. Please take this into consideration when allocating the performance space/auditorium size.

Technical Requirements

- **Get-in:** 3 hours before half with pre-rig completed prior to get in.
- **Get-out:** 1 hour.
- Venue Configuration: End on.
 Performing area minimum 5m(wide) by 5m (depth) with 3.5m (height).
- **Lighting:** A full lighting plan will be supplied. We will require the use of the venues lighting desk.
- **Sound:** We tour a Mac with QLAB but will need to plug this into the venues P.A. system.
- **Staffing:** On tour, there are 2 performers, access worker plus a company stage manager who will operate lighting and sound, but we do require 1 in-house technician to assist with get-in, focus, plot and the get-out.
- Parking: For a sprinter size van.

- **Facilities:** Dressing rooms for 2 performers.
- Access: A full Access Rider will be provided however please note:
 - There needs to be step free* access into the venue/ auditorium for both artists and audiences.
 - There needs to be step free access onto/into the performance area for both artists and audiences.
 - One accessible, secure and heated dressing room and accessible toilet facilities near the performance space.
 - Step free routes between the dressing room, back stage and performance area.
 - For those venues who are providing transfers, hospitality or accommodation, this should be wheel chair accessible and step free.

*Step-free access means lifts, ramps and level surfaces where you don't have to use stairs or escalators. Even just one step means it is not step free and not accessible.

N.B. for those venues who are providing transfers, hospitality or accommodation, this should be wheelchair accessible and step free. Please enquire.

Technical Requirements (non-traditional spaces inc rural/community touring spaces and libraries)

Note that the piece can perform self-sufficiently without blackout as we can tour our own sound. All we need is 1 contact to help with get-ins. Set-up times are 90 mins, exit within 45 mins. This flexibility allows families/children to access the work where they live, go to school or spend their free time.

A gentle and immersive multi-sensory experience

Come in, relax, find a space and settle.

Slowly, a shimmering surface emerges.

What does it look like?

How does it move?

Listen, what can you hear?

Welcome to a world of shiny things.

Welcome to Glisten!

Glisten is an interactive performance for babies aged 0-18 months and their grown-ups. The audience are taken on a sparkling and shimmering immersive journey exploring the world of reflective materials, wrapped up in an ambient soundscape of evocative yet laid-back music. Watch as the empty space of the theatre fills with colour, sounds and surprises, creating a sensory landscape ready to explore after the performance is over.

Glisten is performed to a small audience creating an intimate and welcoming theatrical experience, beautifully co-created by theatre-maker Daniel Naddafy and visual artist Phoebe Stubbs.

This show is suitable for performances at any time of year, and is particularly popular for the festive period.

Glisten has toured to much acclaim since 2018 to over 50 venues, including extended runs at Warwick Arts Centre, Chichester Festival Theatre and South Street Arts Centre, Reading, in December 2022

This show has limited dialogue. This makes it accessible to a range of people, including d/Deaf, hard of hearing and non-English speakers.

Performance Length and Audience Restrictions

- Performances last 20 minutes (no interval), followed by an interactive free-play session where the babies can explore the tactile world of *Glisten*.
- Due to the intimate nature of the production, it is designed for audiences of up to 40 (children and adults).

Touring Details:

- Available on request for venues or non-traditional space format at anytime of the year.
- Please note: this show is only available for blocks of five or more days in one venue or as part of a touring circuit, including international touring. Please enquire.

Technical Requirements (venues/locations with full blackout only)

- **Get-in:** 75 minutes before half with simple 1 light pre-rig completed. The show is otherwise self-contained (see below).
- **Get-out:** 45 minutes after audience have cleared.
- Venue configuration: The piece works best in an open studio format with a flat floor. A full black out is required. The set consists of a marquee frame which is 4 meters wide by 3 meters deep. This sits on a minimum performing area of 5m (width) by 4m (depth) by 3m (height). This footprint includes room for the audience to sit. They are seated in a traverse format with the first row on cushions (toured) and a second row made up from either benches or chairs (venue to supply). If the performance space has fixed seating, please block these off. This is a limited capacity piece of 40.

- Lighting: A small, simple pre-rig of three lanterns is required (PAR64 CP62 downlight and two zoom profiles cross-lights all with no colour). We tour four lighting stands with either two/three LED PAR64. These are positioned back from the centre of each side of the frame. If the floor space is small, then the stands will be positioned at each corner of the marquee frame. Each stand will require a 13A supply please. We tour an ETC nomad so require a DMX connection to house dimmers to control any houselights and the 3 overhead units. The control position will be near to the performing space and confirmed upon arrival. A 13A supply will be required at this point. As we use wireless DMX there will be no DMX cables to the stands only the venues 13Amp supplies.
- Sound: We are touring a laptop with QLAB. We will require a stereo mini-jack input in to P.A. preferably with a D.I. box. The sound should emanate from the performance area
- **Staffing**: There is one performer who will operate lighting and sound, but we do require 1 in-house technician to assist with get-in, focus, plot and the get-out.
- Facilities: Lockable dressing room.
- Parking: Parking and get in access for small 2-seater van.



Heartfelt, provocative and full of quirky humour, Party features striking, colourful designs and exuberant physicality set to the beats of a glorious Fado inspired contemporary soundtrack. Let the warmth of a Portuguese summer take you to a place where difference is something to celebrate.

The show offers a poignant and popular exploration of diversity for the very young.

Party toured to much acclaim in 2022 to over 30 venues including a residency at London's South Bank Centre and MAC's Outsiders Festival.

The alternative lo-tech version of the production also toured to over 40 schools and libraries during the summer of 2022.

This show has extremely limited dialogue. This makes it accessible to a range of people, including d/Deaf, hard of hearing and non-English speakers.

Performance Information

- Performances last 40 mins (no interval).
- 1 or 2 shows a day.
- If a 2-show day, a minimum of 90 minutes between the end of the first show and the start of the next (e.g. 11am & 1.15pm) is required.

Technical / Venue Requirements

- Get-in: 90 mins minimum before half with prerig completed prior to get in.
- **Get-out:** 70 mins.
- **Venue Configuration:** End on. Performing area minimum 6.5m meters (wide) by 5.5m (depth) with 3.5m (height).
- Setting: Black box theatre presentation. No wing space required.
- **Lighting:** A lighting plan will be supplied. We will require the use of the venues Lighting Desk.
- **Sound:** We tour a Mac with QLAB but will need to plug this into the venues P.A. system.
- Technical staff: 1 technician to assist with get-in, focusing and the get out. If Lighting and Sound cannot be operated together then the venue technician will be required to operate lighting allowing communication between them and our Company Stage Manager. We tour with a Company Stage Manager.
- **Parking:** For a sprinter size van.
- Facilities: Dressing rooms for 1 male performer.

Technical Requirements (non-traditional spaces inc rural/community touring spaces and libraries)

Note that the piece can be performed in settings without blackout as we bring everything we need on tour. We just need access in the 'performing space' to 2 x 13A plugs. Please enquire for details.

Technical Information:

For audiences to view at home via an online streaming platform, at a time that suits them:

Productions will be made available on a password protected Vimeo link, which will need to be passed onto bookers (link and password). Alternatively, the shows can be embedded onto the venue's website and the page link sent to bookers. Audiences will still need to enter the password to access the video. This will be available for your audiences to view for 14 days following the date of the last programmed online show. After this time the video will no longer be available to watch as the password will expire. Venues will not be sent a digital file of the booked show to download.

For a live screening or at a specific date and time online experience:

Venues will be released the full MP4 file so that a venue can play it through their own playback or cinema system. Captions will be sent as a separate SRT file for you to upload to your platform. This is for 1 day (2 showings are permitted per day). Venues are required to delete the MP4 file after use and not distribute to anyone else.
